

Hope Scholarship Committee on Appeals Minutes

The meeting of the Hope Scholarship Committee on Appeal was called to order by Jamion Wolford, Chair, on Friday January 30, 2026, at 3:05 P.M. after determination that a quorum of members was present through a silent roll call. Approval of the Minutes

The Chair indicated the first item on the agenda was the approval of the minutes of the December 17, 2025, meeting, which were distributed to the members prior to the meeting. The Chair asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes and none were noted. Alice Bonnell moved to approve the minutes, and the motion was seconded by Michael Cook. The Chair asked for discussion; none was heard. The Chair polled the members and the motion to approve the minutes was adopted.

Review and Consideration of Applicant Appeals

The Chair indicated the next item on the agenda of the meeting was the review and consideration of applicant appeals pursuant to W.Va. CSR 112-19-11. Michael Cook made a motion to enter Executive Session as provided in *[West Virginia Code, Chapter 6, Article 9A, Section (4), Subsection (b), Subdivision (12)]*, which states a public agency may hold an Executive Session if there is discussion of

“...any matter which, by express provision of federal law or state statute or rule of court is rendered confidential, or which is not considered a public record within the meaning of the freedom of information act.” The Chair seconded the motion. No discussion was heard. The Chair polled the members, and the motion was approved to move into Executive Session.

The Chair advised members of the public to log off and wait a few minutes before logging back in, where they would be held in the TEAMS lobby until the Executive Session was complete. The Committee entered the Executive Session at 3:08 P.M. There were only board members and board staff in attendance.

The Board returned to order at 3:15 P.M. The Chair issued a reminder that no action was taken during the Executive Session.

Alice Bonnell made the following motion regarding applicant appeals:

For appeals #402 through 407, I hereby move the appeals be denied and that the Hope Scholarship Board staff notify the applicants of the Committee’s determination.

The Chair asked if any member of the committee wished to vote separately on any of the application appeals and the offer was declined. Michael Cook seconded the motion. Hearing no discussion, the Chair polled the members, and the motion carried.

Review and Consideration of Reimbursement Appeals

The Chair indicated the next item on the agenda of the meeting was the review and consideration of reimbursement of appeals pursuant to W.Va. CSR 112-19-11. Alice Bonnell made a motion to enter Executive Session as provided in *[West Virginia Code, Chapter 6, Article 9A, Section (4), Subsection (b), Subdivision (12)]*, which states a public agency may hold an Executive Session if there is discussion of “...any matter which, by express provision of federal law or state statute or rule of court is rendered confidential, or which is not considered a public record within the meaning of the freedom of information act.” Michael Cook seconded the motion. The Chair asked if any member of the committee wished to vote separately on any of the reimbursement appeals and the offer was declined. Alice Bonnell seconded the motion. Hearing no discussion, the Chair polled the members, and the motion carried.

Review and Consideration of Provider Appeals

The Chair indicated the next item on the agenda of the meeting was the review and consideration of provider appeals pursuant to W.Va. CSR 112-19-11. Alice Bonnell made a motion to enter Executive Session as provided in *[West Virginia Code, Chapter 6, Article 9A, Section (4), Subsection (b), Subdivision (12)]*, which states a public agency may hold an Executive Session if there is discussion of "...any matter which, by express provision of federal law or state statute or rule of court is rendered confidential, or which is not considered a public record within the meaning of the freedom of information act." Michael Cook seconded the motion. No discussion was heard. The Chair polled the members, and the motion was approved to move into Executive Session.

The Chair indicated that the next order of business was to discuss future meetings. He stated that the Committee on Appeals will meet as needed depending on eligibility appeals received by staff. Staff will coordinate with Committee members on the need for meetings when appeals are received. The date and time of any meetings will be announced later in accordance with the Open Meetings Act.


No additional discussion was heard regarding future meetings.

Adjournment

The Chair asked if there was any other business to come before the Committee on Appeals. None was heard. Michael Cook made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Alice Bonnell seconded the motion. Upon hearing no discussion, the Chair polled the members and the motion to adjourn the meeting passed. The meeting was adjourned at 3:49 P.M.
